Effective June 11, 2018, Kitsap Community Resources (KCR) Executive Board Committee has placed KCR Executive Director David Wunderlin on administrative leave. The Board is conducting an investigation into allegations that Wunderlin was simultaneously employed as Executive Director of Kitsap Community Resources and Executive Director of The ARC Southwest Washington.

Wunderlin will remain on administrative leave pending the outcome of an inquiry into these allegations. As an interim measure, KCR Fiscal Officer, Irmgard Davis, has been named Acting, Executive Director.

Day-to-day operations will not be impacted in any way. KCR's established systems of operations, tenured executive leadership team, and compassionate team members will continue doing the work of serving low-income Kitsap County families and upholding the trust of funders, donors, and community partners.

In the process of thoroughly evaluating these allegations, respecting confidentiality, and ensuring the continued focus on serving Kitsap County residents in need; no further comments will be made to the media until the KCR Executive Committee has completed its review.
