tradition fosters a sense of community by uniting volunteers and donors to spread holiday cheer.

Traditionally, the Christmas Angel Program has focused on supporting families receiving case-managed services through KCR. Last year, we assisted over 300 of these families. However, thanks to the overwhelming generosity of our donors, we were able to expand the program to include the broader community, reaching over 1,000 children during the 2023 holiday season.



HOW THE PROGRAM WORKS

SET UP

The process begins in October, when our team collects Christmas Angel registration forms from KCR case-managed families and other members of the community. These forms help us understand the specific needs and wishes of each family.

In November, we focus on gathering donations and setting up what we call the "Santa Shop."
Thanks to the generosity of our community, the shop is stocked with a variety of gifts.

SANTA SHOP

opens, allowing registered families to come in and "shop" for gifts for their children at no cost. In 2023, families were able to select two toys (or one rideable toy like a bike or scooter), two items of clothing, one book, one family game, one stuffed animal/ blanket, and two stocking stuffers. Our goal is to ensure that each family experiences the magic of the holiday season, with gifts tailored to their children's needs and wishes.
